

Torrox Declaration

March 26-29, 2014, in Torrox - Malaga, Spain; More than 100 Latin workers convened by COMIBAM International, Mission for the Third Millennium and Back to Europe, gathered for the Encounter of Latin Americans Working in Europe (ELTE).

During the course of the group we had the opportunity to hear the Word of God, to share testimonies of the call to participate in the evangelization of Europe, to reflect on the diverse events that have occurred in the performance of the task, and the relationships that have formed either with the church and evangelical leadership of Europe.

The participants came from 10 different nationalities of Latin America, working now in Germany, Belgium, Spain, France, The Netherlands, Portugal, United Kingdom and Sweden. Also keeping in mind the many others that were neither present or represented as they are working hard in the same or other European countries, which we hope to include in future; as well as those who came as international observers.

In a spirit of prayer and partnership, and with the goal of amplifying and deepening the relationship between Latin American workers and the European evangelical leaders, and with the objective of the good advance the Kingdom of God in Europe; and with a heart and identity including and inclusive of everyone, to all this continuous process,

We are to:

1. Form, strengthen and develop the network of ELTE.
2. Build two-way bridges between the Latin American church and the European church.
3. Develop a reciprocal collaboration between Latin American missionaries and other different existing Latin American platforms with European pastors and leaders, extending the ties of brotherhood between the two.
4. Offer our unconditional service to the church in Europe in a spirit of humility and reciprocity.
5. Participate with determination in the evangelization efforts in all of Europe.

For that which we commend to the Triune God, by whom we know we are set apart for this challenge of renewing our commitment to the cause of the Kingdom of God.
